AGE REQUIREMENTS

Children must turn the minimum age required for the camp they are registered, on or before the day in which the camp starts. All children must be fully potty trained. CHILDREN ARE GROUPED BY AGE. THE MUSEUM WILL NOT PROMISE PAIRING OF CAMPER.

PAYMENT

A 50% deposit is required; per child, per session; to reserve a space in camp. The remaining balance will be automatically charged to the credit card on file the Wednesday prior to camp date the child is registered. If a credit card is not left on file, it is the parent’s responsibility to contact Young At Art and pay the balance on that Wednesday. Failure to pay the balance on time will result in a \$15 late fee. All deposits and payments are NON-REFUNDABLE including voluntary or mandatory withdrawal from camp. See transfer info.

TRANSFER

All Transfer requests must be submitted in writing two weeks prior to start date on the appropriate transfer form. Transfer approval requires a \$25.00 fee per child, per transfer and will be made depending on space availability. Payments are not transferable to anyone outside of the immediate family. Submit transfer requests to Visitor Services office in person or by emailing artinstitute@youngatartmuseum.org.

ABSENCE / CANCELLATION / NO SHOW

Absences, withdrawals, no-shows or dismissals will not be eligible for refunds, transfers, make-ups, or credits.

CAMP DROP OFF/PICK UP POLICY

For the first day and every day of camp thereafter for each session, your child must be escorted into the building by a parent/guardian for check-in. Children registered for before care may be dropped off 8:00am to 8:45am. All others may be dropped off 8:45am to 9:15am.

EARLY DROP-OFF/LATE PICK-UP (Must be escorted into building for check-in)

Students dropped off before 8:45am and picked up after 5:00pm will be automatically charged for extended care at a rate of \$15.00 per day. Extended care students picked up after 6:00pm will be automatically charged for extended care for \$15, plus \$5.00 and an additional \$1.00 per minute until the child is picked up.

PHOTO RELEASE

I authorize Young At Art Museum to take photographs of my child/children and their art work for Marketing purposes. I give permission for these pictures to be used in the museum’s printed materials, social media and website, including advertisements, brochures, and flyers. If you do not wish for your child to be photographed, please ensure your child receives a RED “No Photo” wristband upon sign-in daily.

BEHAVIOR POLICY

Young At Art Museum is a safe place for children and families. Safety includes physical and emotional well-being. In order to maintain a safe camp environment, each child is asked to also “help keep it safe” by following camp rules. The rules include, but are not limited to: keeping hands and feet to themselves, using kind words and inside voices, walking, staying with their teachers, group and volunteer at all times, using inside voices, respecting themselves, peers, teachers, volunteers, artwork, classrooms and exhibits. When children choose not to follow any of these rules, The following is put in place:

- 1st offense – Verbal warning and reminder of the rules
- 2nd offense – Consequences for their actions (possibly missing out on activities) and parent notification
- 3rd offense – Parent notification via phone or in person and a behavior report is filed
- 4th offense – Parent meeting with Art Institute Manager
- 5th offense – Possible suspension or expulsion from Young At Art’s Summer Program

Any action committed by a child that could or does result in injury to themselves, other campers, volunteers or staff could result in immediate expulsion from Young At Art’s Summer Program. No refunds are given if child is dismissed due to behavior issues.

CAMP EQUIPMENT

The replacement value of any equipment damaged or broken by your child, including but not limited to iPads, iMacs, cameras, etc. will be charged to your account. The payment must be paid in full before the end of your child's session.

EXTREME WEATHER

In the event of a hurricane, tornado, flood, fire, or other acts of GOD, Young At Art Museum will take the proper safety precautions and will close the building if there is an immanent threat. If the building closes and camp is cancelled, additional program dates will be issued to make up the time that the camp program was not in session. For the latest updates check the museum website, facebook pages, and voicemail for when the museum will reopen.

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

In the event of an extreme medical emergency, Young At Art staff will contact emergency medical personnel and will then contact the child's parent or guardian. Based on medical personnel's assessment, your child may be transported to a local hospital to receive further medical attention. Requests to alter this policy must be made in writing to the Art Institute Manager. Emergency Medical personnel will not honor requests to bring children to specific hospitals, doctors or medical establishments.

MEDICATION FORM

If your child needs to take medication during camp hours please fill out a MEDICATION FORM at sign-in. You can obtain a medication form from the Camp Check-in staff. Please pack all medication(s) in a sealed Ziploc bag, clearly labeled with your child's name, age, medication, teacher name, dosage and time to deliver, along with dosage cup. Medications will be stored in the Education office. Epipens will be given to the child's teacher.

SICK POLICY

Your child will be sent home if (s)he exhibits any of the following symptoms: lice, high fever (100°F or higher), extremely red eyes, green mucus, vomiting, diarrhea, severe perpetual cough, or difficulty breathing. Campers are welcome back when they are 24 hours fever free without using fever reducing medication, and have not thrown up or had any diarrhea for 24 hours. You may be asked to present a doctor's note prior to bringing your child back to camp. Refunds will not be issued for days missed.

INJURIES/ACCIDENTS

If your child is injured while in camp, our staff will provide basic first aid. Depending on the severity of the injury, you may be contacted by phone. An incident report will be filled out and placed in your child's records. If your child has an accident that requires a change of clothes, you will be called to either bring a change of clothes or pick up your child.

IMMUNIZATION

All children attending camp must be fully immunized. By signing I am stating that all children named on this form are immunized and are current on the well child screenings.

I have read and understand the above camp policies and agree to adhere to all policies as stated.

I - including my spouse, child/children/other members of my family, do hereby release and hold harmless Young At Art Museum, its employees, volunteers, board members and related parties from all liability for lost and stolen personal items, injuries or losses as a result of attending or having child(ren) attending and/or participating in any class/camp, program, tour or other function of the museum and hereby consent to the camp rules, guidelines and agreement.
